



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Skagit County Hearing Examiner will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, May 27, 2015** in the Board of County Commissioners Hearing Room, 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, Washington, at **9:00 a.m.** or soon thereafter, for the purpose of determining the following:

- A. **Special Use permit application #PL14-0499** submitted by Loran Brokaw, on behalf of Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) and C.K. Eidem on behalf of Ducks Unlimited, for the "*Samish Wildlife Unit Enhancement*" project. The project proposal will improve the drainage system at the Samish Unit allowing WDFW to effectively manage water on the 409 acre site for wildlife and agricultural purposes. The proposed project is located within the Agricultural Natural Resource Lands (Ag-NRL) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area. The proposed project is located at 12296 Samish Island Road, at the Samish Unit of the Skagit Wildlife Area, on 409 acres of agricultural land along Samish Island Road, Bow, within a portion of Sections 1, 6, 7, and 12 Township 35 North, Ranges 2 and 3 East, within unincorporated Skagit County, WA.
